What is a Haiku?

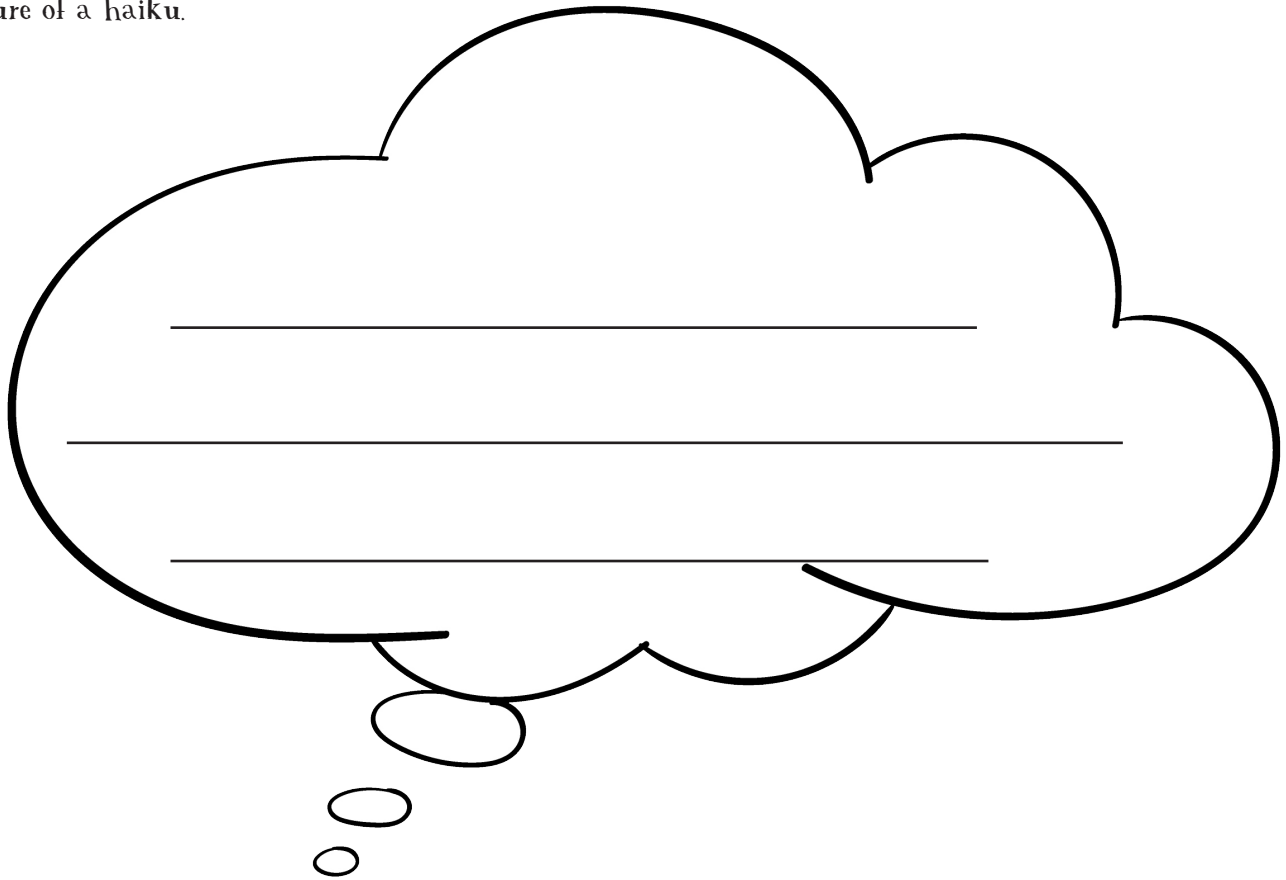
